

Underwater Photography Course

Want to take great photos with your digital underwater camera? South Australian Underwater Photographer, Paul Macdonald will be running an underwater photography course in Edithburgh. Edithburgh is a magnificent location for easy shore based diving and completing your PADI Digital Underwater Photography



course. The cost of the course is \$375 and includes 2 course and 2 practice dives Edithburgh Jetty (plus an option for a recreational night dive), two nights accommodation at Sultana Point Lodge and Breakfast each morning. Non diving partners are also welcome at a cost of \$85. The course is very much hands on and involves reading the PADI Digital Underwater Photographer manual and completing the knowledge reviews prior to the



weekend, 2 photography skills dives, a post dive workshop and lots of fun. At downunderpix we also include 2 practice dives following the course. The PADI Digital Underwater Photographer course helps student divers develop the knowledge, skills and practical techniques necessary to obtain excellent photographs with a digital camera. Section One of the course guides students in achieving good results easily. It is designed as an introduction to course skills and knowledge. Students learn what equipment they need to take great underwater photographs, how to prepare their underwater photo system, and basic underwater photo techniques while diving in an environmentally friendly manner. In Section Two students learn how to make their photographs even better. It covers what they need to know about file formats, resolution settings, making their images lighter or darker, getting good colour, composing their photo, downloading photographs into their computer and adjusting them to look their best.
